3206 Beach Patrol is a team of local residents, who through a small individual contribution of one hours voluntary beach cleaning per month, will become a part of a large community force that will make our beach, from Langridge St to Kerferd Rd, a much cleaner and safer place, more of the time.

3206 Beach Patrol is here to stay. People will become part of a permanent group, whose regular cleaning over time, aided hopefully by a smoking ban imposed by the City of Port Phillip, will make our beach a much safer, healthier and enjoyable place for all who use, see and visit it. !

You are warmly invited to join the team and if possible come to our launch this coming Sunday, December 13th at 8am.

Signing up and The Launch

- A. Signing up is free and easy. Just decide to commit to one hours beach cleaning a month, completed at your convenience and in a zone of your choice.
- B. Log on to www.3206beachpatrol.com.au and go to “sign up now” to provide your details and select your zone. The zones are - 1. Kerferd Rd to Mills St. - 2. Mills St to Harold St. - 3. Harold St to Armstrong St. - 4. Armstrong St to Langridge St.
- C. You immediately become a member of the patrol and your name will appear on the members list. It would be greatly appreciated if you could sign up before the launch so we know how many t-shirts we need !
- D. Come to the launch and you will be issued with your free t shirt, a pair of gloves and a garbage bag. The launch kicks off with a quick meet and greet at the Albert Park Angling Club followed by glove, bag and t shirt issue. There after approximately 15 members will clean the beach down to Langridge St, with the remainder of the crew staying back to play with the kids and enjoy themselves. A bus will be waiting to collect the cleaning group at Langridge St and then travel back to collect all members and children waiting at Kerferd Rd. The whole group will then bus on up to **NACIONAL** on Mills St, for a coffee (arrival time approx 9.45am)

- E. From there on after you *complete your one hour a month at your convenience* using your own garbage bags. Make sure you wear your 3206 Beach Patrol t shirt and gloves when you do your cleaning!

Please note members must be a minimum of 10 years of age to join up but *all* children are welcome to the launch. If you can't make the launch join up anyway and contact us by email to arrange your t-shirt and glove collection.
